INT. MRS. CAMBELL'S CLASSROOM - DAY

JAMIE

FOR (COVERING) Uh, so ready. Only problem is (COUGHING) I'm sick.

MRS. CAMBELL

The nurse can take your temperature.

JAMIE

Wait, miracle! I'm better! Except, I just remembered that my dog--

MRS. CAMBELL

I thought you didn't have a dog.

JAMIE

Did I say dog? I meant mom. ate my notecards.

MRS. CAMBELL

Your mom eats paper?

JAMIE

(OFFENDED) It's a very real problem!

MRS. CAMBELL

You'll just have to do without notecards.

JAMIE

You're right. So... for my presentation... I decided... I'm doing an interpretive dance.

JENNY

KAYLA

I don't like singing in front of people.

JENNY

You're not in front of people, it's just me. Close your eyes and pretend I'm not here.

Kayla closes her eyes takes a deep breath. Jenny turns the camera on Kayla as she sings.

Kayla opens her eyes and stares down the camera lens. She clams up, glaring at Jenny.

KAYLA

What are you doing?! I said I didn't want to be on camera.

Kayla shields her face from the camera.

JENNY

This could totally get us noticed.

KAYLA

Turn the camera off.

JENNY

KAYLA

She snatches the camera from Jenny and turns it off.

JENNY

Don't you want to do this anymore?

KAYLA

Kayla grabs her backpack and throws it over her shoulder.

JENNY

Where are you going?

KAYLA

I'm tired of going along with your dumb-ass plans. You're the only one who can't see how stupid this whole thing is. Call me when you've gotten this power trip out of your system.

Kayla storms out of the room, slamming the door behind her.
